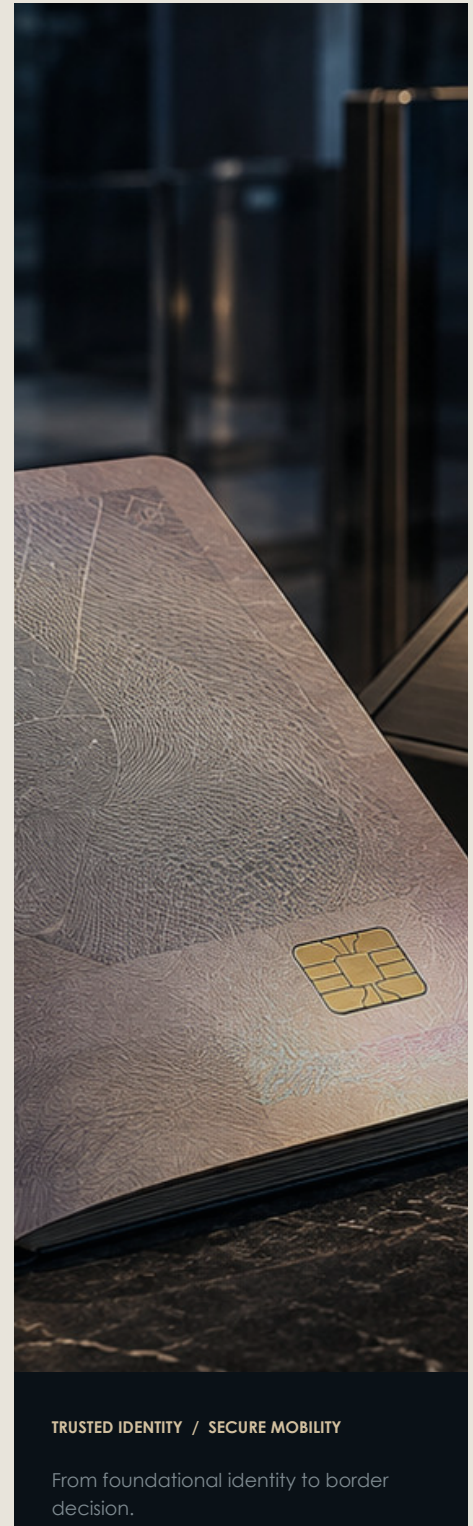

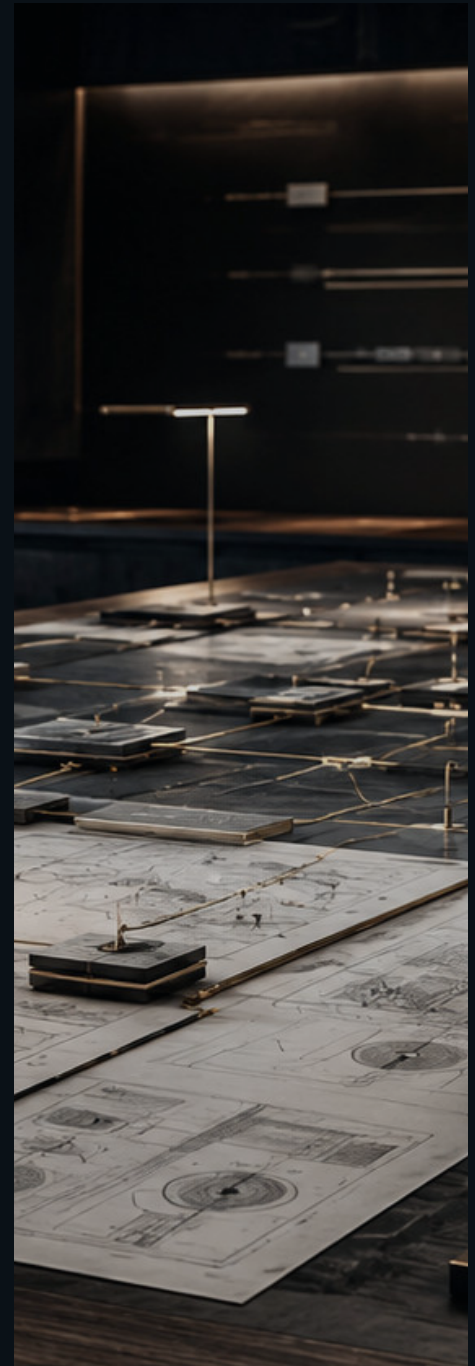
COMMISSION

• ORIGINS OF IDENTITY ASSURANCE

Before biometrics, *identity became visible.*

Human communities first established trust through witnessed presence, lineage, names, marks, seals, and records. These instruments tied a person, office, or authority to an act.

PERIODS OVERLAP / SYMBOLS ARE INTERPRETIVE



C. 3500-539 BCE

Mesopotamia

CYLINDER SEAL IMPRESSION

Rolled clay impressions marked ownership, witnessed transactions, secured goods, or confirmed signatures.



C. 3100-30 BCE

Ancient Egypt

SCARAB SEAL-AMULET + ROYAL CARTOUCHE

Scarab seals could carry names or titles and secure goods; cartouches framed royal names.



C. 2500-1700 BCE

Indus Valley

INSCRIBED STAMP SEAL

Standardized seals appear in trade and administrative contexts; their script and precise uses remain unsettled.



C. 1600 BCE-1912 CE

Ancient China

OFFICIAL AND PERSONAL SEAL

Seals recorded a person's name or government title and served as signatures on documents.



C. 800-146 BCE

Ancient Greece

ENGRAVED SIGNET

Engraved gems authenticated owners and acts; some city-states also maintained civic status records.



27 BCE-476 CE

Roman Empire

STAMP, SEAL, AND CIVIC RECORD

Household marks and legal records connected names to property, office, service, and rights.

IDENTITY ASSURANCE BEFORE SCIENTIFIC BIOMETRICS

The recurring question: how can a community trust that a named person, represented authority, property claim, or recorded act is genuine?

FROM SYMBOLIC TRUST TO MEASURED IDENTITY

Authority became documented. *Identity became measurable.*

Across regions, portable credentials and administrative records strengthened verification. In the modern era, repeatable human traits became searchable, comparable evidence.

8TH-14TH CENTURY / CALIPHATES

Islamic Golden Age

INSCRIBED PERSONAL SEAL

Name-bearing seals authenticated goods and documents within administrative and commercial life.



330-1453 CE

Byzantine Empire

LEAD SEAL OR BULLA

Personalized lead seals guarded and authenticated correspondence and objects, recording office and status.



C. 2000 BCE-1500 CE

Maya Civilization

NAME, TITLE, AND PLACE GLYPH

Hieroglyphic inscriptions recorded rulers, dynasties, events, calendars, and political identities.



1206-1368 CE

Mongol Empire

PAIZA SAFE-CONDUCT TABLET

Portable tablets conveyed delegated authority and protected movement across imperial routes.



16TH-20TH CENTURY

British Empire

PASSPORT, REGISTRY, FINGERPRINT FILE

Passes and registers formalized documentary identity; Haque, Bose, and Henry made fingerprint files searchable.



1776-PRESENT

United States

BIOMETRIC RECORD AND DIGITAL CREDENTIAL

Fingerprint repositories became automated search systems; separate credentials added biometric verification.



Definition boundary: Modern biometrics uses measurable physical or behavioral characteristics for recognition or verification. Earlier seals, marks, and credentials are predecessors of identity verification - not biometric systems.
